
## **PMRA Label Search Instructions**

The following are instructions on how to navigate the Label Search tool on the PMRA's website using Pyrate 480 EC as an example and screenshots to illustrate each step.

PMRA Website: Pesticide Label Search - Health Canada (hc-sc.gc.ca)


To complete a search, go to Initial Criteria (second fillable option) and put in whatever search criteria you would like to use (PCPA Number may be the easiest). Note you only have to use one of the following search criteria:

- CAS #
- Active Ingredient
- Product Name (Trade Name)
- Registrant Name (Manufacturer)
- Registration Number (PCPA Number)



Next, go down to Registration Status and click on all three options (make sure this is done with each query):

- Registered
- Exempted
- Historical



Click Submit Search Requirements and you will find the specific product (if using PCPA number or trade name) or products containing the AI.



From here, you can see the registration status, click on the product name for additional information on the registration or click on the registration number for the most current label. Ensure the product is registered and approved for use on turf/golf courses. Historical means the product registration has expired. Refer to product information (click on product name) for expiry dates. Dispose of historical products past expiry date of registration via a CleanFarms pesticide drop off or through a licensed hazardous waste disposal service such as Clean Harbors.
